



The National Capital Region Market military pharmacies will transition to a new electronic health record in March 2023. Prescriptions are more efficiently and safely processed when submitted electronically. Thank you in advance for your patience as we transition!

What is an Electronic Prescription?

An electronic prescription is a computer-generated prescription sent electronically from your health care provider directly to our pharmacy. Electronic prescriptions are sent using a private, secure, and closed network. Your prescription information is not sent over the internet or as an email.

Why Ask for an Electronic Prescription?

Your electronic prescription is sent directly from your providers to our pharmacy eliminating the need to drop off a paper prescription. The electronic process can help prevent medication errors, suggest alternative drugs to save money, and process prescriptions more efficiently.

Will My Prescription be Ready When I Arrive at the Pharmacy?

The pharmacy does not automatically fill every prescription written by on or off base providers. You must first contact the pharmacy to activate your electronic prescription by:

Beginning 1 Jan 23, please have your provider send your prescriptions electronically to military pharmacies for all non-controlled drugs and after 1 Apr 23 for controlled drugs.

National Capital Region Market pharmacies will no longer accept routine hardcopy or paper prescriptions. Exceptions will be made only for prescriptions written by Emergency or Dental providers or provider offices without eRx capabilities.

- Ask your doctor to send your prescription electronically to our pharmacy.

- When you arrive at our pharmacy, let us know that the prescription was sent electronically.
